The impending visit of Prime Minister Narendra Modi to the United States to attend the United Nations General Assembly and also to meet US President Barack Obama will be a significant step to set the tone and outcomes of US-India relations.

'The importance of this visit lies in the fact that both parties are striving to draw a fresh first sketch on a blank-slate with a new prime minister at the helm in New Delhi. While officials are planning to generate as much value out of Modi's trip to New York and Washington, DC, it is also time to create newer values in the bilateral relation. Of course, included in the itinerary would be a meeting or town-hall with the technology CEOs, and a private dinner with the owner-CEOs of som these top corporations,

Moreover, the Silicon Valley is no l er only about information technol software and social media. The techno giants are moving towards innovat products and solutions for smart c and waste management, clean techno and solar energy, and advances in le ing through tools like the Massive C Online Course, among others.

India must take the leadershi inspiring this eco-system of innova and entrepreneurship towards crea affordable solutions for the needs of billions across the world.

Despite the overwhelming American lawmakers to invite Prime Minister Narendra Modi to address a joint Session of US Congress when he visits Washington in September-end, the much-touted event is unlikely to take place because of campaigning preoccupations of members for the Congressional elections scheduled for early November.

Although there has been no official word yet, the US India Political Action Committee, which had haunched a grassroots campaign on this score and met Speaker John Boehner, said on Tuesday that the plan for Modi address to Congress was off
